1. Wildlife Park & Brief City Tour

Wildlife Park is located 25km from Kota Kinabalu on 280 acres of forested land. It is only 15-25 minutes journey from the city where you could experience wildlife animals in the Park itself. After Lunch, get to know Kota Kinabalu better by visiting the Sabah State Museum and its Heritage Village. This provides an insight into the culture and history of Sabah's indigenous peoples. Continue for Photo-stop at the Likas City Mosque before proceeding to the Tun Mustapha then return to Hotel Free at own leisure.

Price per person: RM230

2. City Tour

Get to know Kota Kinabalu better by visiting the Sabah State Museum and its Heritage Village. This provides an insight into the culture and history of Sabah's indigenous peoples. Photo-stop at the Likas City Mosque then proceed to the Handicraft Center (Previously known as the Pilipino Market). Then proceed for lunch at a local restaurant. And after lunch transfer back to hotel free at own leisure.

3. Garama Wetlands Boat Cruise

Garama wetlands and swamps are natural habitats and home to some of Borneo's amazing wildlife. Upon arrival at Garama, light refreshments are served. Take a leisurely boat cruise into the wetlands and through riverine forests. Possible wildlife sightings include mammals such as the endemic proboscis monkey, macaque, silver langur, the nocturnal fruitbat; reptiles like the monitor lizard, crocodile, mangrove snake; and birds like the kingfisher, heron, brahminy kite and egret. The boat cruises till sunset and on the return journey, watch for the fireflies that congregate in hundreds around the mangrove trees. Enjoy a pleasant dinner by the river.

4. Kinabalu Park

Kinabalu Park is the first World Heritage Site of Malaysia. While driving along the highway to Kinabalu Park, we will stop at Nabal Market for handicrafts and meet the indigenous Dusun people. At the Park, take a 2 hour trek on one of the many graded trails into the montane forest. This is a good opportunity for bird-watching or nature photography, or learning of the medicinal uses of the forest plants. Lunch is served at the Park. Visit the Exhibit Centre, the Mountain Garden and the Heritage Gallery.

Price per person: RM190 (Minimum 2 person)

5. 2 Days/1night Turtle Island Sepilok

Guest will have to travel by air to Sandakan Airport and transfer to jetty and embark for a boat ride for about 1 hour to Selangan Island one of the three islands of Turtle Island Park. Check-in and enjoy the Sun, Sea and Sand for the whole day. At night after dinner wait at the cafeteria for the ranger's signal to witness the process of Green Turtle lay eggs, transplanting the eggs to hatchery for protection and watch the newly hatch baby turtles been release to the sea. Over night at chalet, free at own leisure.

The next morning after breakfast depart island back to mainland Sandakan. Upon arrival for about half an hour drive to Sepilok Orang-Utan Rehabilitation Centre where orphaned and injured Orang-Utan are brought to Sepilok to be rehabilitated to return and fend for themselves back to the wild. Sepilok is a primary lowland forest, a fine showcase of Borneo's remaining rainforest. Witness the feeding of Orang-Utan from a platform in the forest. Watch the 25 minutes scheduled video documentary show. Proceed for Lunch to Sabah Hotel. After lunch depart for Sandakan Nature City Tour. Arrive at Sandakan Memorial Park. Depart for Puu Jih Shih Buddhist Temple. Depart observation pavilion and Drive to the Central Market. Then transfer to Sandakan Airport, upon arrival in Kota Kinabalu transfer to Hotel.

6. 2 Days 1 Night Sepilok Orang Utan/Bilit Kinabatangan River/ Morning Cruise/Gomantong Cave/Sandakan City (Fullboard)

Sandakan/Sepilok Orang Utan/Bilit Kinabatangan River

Guest will have to travel to Sandakan Airport by air and transfer to Sepilok Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre, watching one of the nature's most endangered animal species, the 'Orang Utan' or 'Man of the Jungle'. Guest will watch the scheduled video show programme (20 mins) and visit to the Exhibition Hall. After lunch, drive overland to Bilit Adventure Lodge (BAL), located at Sabah's longest river, Kinabatangan River. Upon arrival, check into your accommodation with basic facilities. Follow by an afternoon tea and a short briefing by your nature guide. At 1600 hrs, enjoy a boat cruise (2 hrs) along the Kinabatangan River to see all the amazing wildlife gathered by the riverbank. Return to Bilit Lodge for dinner and have an overnight stay. Optional Night Walk can be arrange and pay locally.

Bilit Kinabatangan/Gomantong Cave/Sandakan City/Airport

After breakfast, morning cruise to ox bow lake after cruise depart for Gomantong Cave, to explore the largest bird's nest cave in Sabah. Return to Sandakan by land. Transfer to Sabah Hotel for lunch. Afternoon, depart for Sandakan Nature City Tour. Visit to Puu Jih Shih Buddhist Temple, photo stop at St. Michael's Church, Water Village, Central Market. Proceed for lunch at Sabah Hotel, then proceed to airport.
