#### **i) GOLF**

Designed by leading golf course designer Graham Marsh, Sutera Harbour Golf Club has garnered various awards of distinction. The course is finished with Bermuda grass and strategically challenging bunkers. Playing any combination of 18 holes, golfers will enjoy a par-72 six thousand metre course. The 27-hole championship golf course is beautifully landscaped with undulating terrain and numerous waterways, providing a challenge for both amateurs and top professionals alike.

#### **ii) ISLAND HOPPING (Mamutik, Sapi & Manukan)**

Sabah has plenty of beautiful and exotic offshore islands, attracting thousands of visitors each year, particularly diving enthusiasts. Crystal-clear waters, pristine sun-drenched beaches and un-spoilt natural beauty are the main characteristics of Sabah's islands.

The Tunku Abdul Rahman Marine Park is a cluster of islands comprising Pulau Gaya, Pulau Sapi, Pulau Manukan, Pulau Mamutik and Pulau Sulug, all only 10 - 20 minute speedboat ride from the city of Kota Kinabalu.

We have organized an Island Hopping trip to the 3 famous islands above as a welcoming social event for our guests. With crystal-clear waters and a colourful marine life, these islands are an excellent venue for all kinds of water sports, snorkeling, scuba diving or just relaxing on the beach.

**Itinerary:**

**0830hrs** To Sutera Marina jetty for a boat ride to Sapi Island in the Tunku Abdul Rahman Marine Park. Free at leisure to swim and snorkel, or take optional sea-sports such as banana boat, parasailing, jet ski etc. By **1100hrs** transfer to Manukan for BBQ lunch at the Island. After lunch, Free at Leisure **1400hrs** transfer to Mamutik Island and by **1700hrs** Return to Marina jetty and free at own leisure.

**Fees: RM280** per person
